You'll use a graphing calculator in every math class (and most science classes) here at Lee Academy—and you'll use it in college, as well.

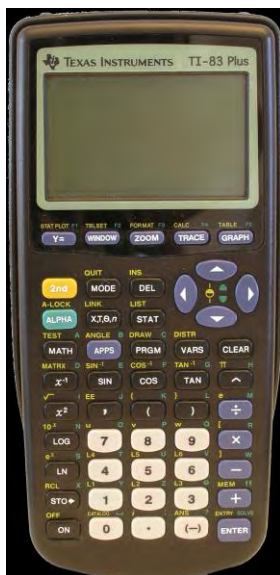
If you don't have one, you really need to buy one.

LA has a few TI-83+ calculators for each math class—but not enough for everyone to have one during class time—and none to loan for home use. If you don't have your own, it will be harder for you to learn math, to do your homework, and to build the technology skills that are an important part of applying your math knowledge in the world.

We believe that you need your own graphing calculator—it's as essential for student's today as a pen or notebook!
